

3-6 YEAR OLD SPEECH

3 Years

- 3 year olds are becoming easier to understand
- Read short, repetitive picture books with them
 - Have your kiddo sing classic nursery rhymes with you

4 years

- 4 year olds are starting to put sentences together
- Have your kiddo sing classic nursery rhymes with you
 - Do a Word Hunt, where you point to objects and name them together

5 Years

- 5 year olds are talking in full sentences
- Have them tell you a story about their favorite stuffed animal
 - Play I Spy and name items with extra details

6 Years

- 6 year olds are able to read simple words
- They can tell you details about thier favorite show or book
 - Have them read a simple book (Dick and Jane, Dr. Suess)

Extras

- This age group is getting ready to read!
- Reading daily will facilitate their vocabulary
 - Making silly tongue twisters or alliteration word games makes reading fun!
