

2-3 YEAR OLD SPEECH

2 year

- Modified version of Simon says (don't have to have a Simon): child should understand action words such as "touch your toes"
- Read their favorite book and point to an image, asking "what is this?"

2 year

- Sing nursery rhymes or songs together
- Play puppets together and have the puppets ask simple questions such as "where is your arm?" or "where's your nose?"

2.5 year

- Go on a walk in the neighborhood and name items (leaves, grass, animals, etc)
- Use blocks (with animals and letters) and name the animal or make the sound

3 year

- Name Game: have an assortment of crayons and name as many as we can together
- Storytelling: have the child tell you a story about a given topic (princesses, superheroes, etc)

Extras

- Read books and have books around the house
- Label items around the house
- Have child count items
